SET UP:

On Friday 4/24/26, vehicles will be allowed on the festival grounds between the hours of 1:00 p.m. to dark at own risk, and overnight security is provided.

SATURDAY, NO VEHICLES ON FESTIVAL GROUNDS. If you must set up on Saturday, use a wagon, hand truck, or similar that can travel between spaces and be ready to open by 8:00 a.m.

CLEAN UP:

Parking passes are required & will be passed out on site when checking in

All vendor items and trash must be removed from premises by 5:30 p.m. Saturday. If

trash is left it can mean an invitation to come back next year may not be available.

EQUIPMENT:

No water hook-ups or electric hook ups are available. Your space could be on soft ground or asphalt. Please bring appropriate anchors to secure your tent. There is very little shade, bring sunscreen.

All vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, and tents (recommended).
Chairs already on festival site are not available for vendor use.

ALCOHOL & DRUGS:

Will not be permitted or tolerated on the grounds.

PETS AND ANIMALS:

Must be leashed and are not allowed in the breakfast area. Just a reminder some days it can be hot, and we want our furry family members to be comfortable. So, remember to bring whatever is needed to make them happy to enjoy the day with you.

Generators:

If you have a generator please let us know. Generators will not be placed in the middle of the festival. We have designated areas for vendors with generators.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT: Vendor is responsible for the quality and safety of what they sell.
